Guidelines for Selecting Project Topic

The following guidelines must be considered before selecting an appropriate topic for your final project:

- Selection of project topic should be made by keeping in view your interest and ability to do quality work on the selected topic.
- Make sure that you can easily gather data on the selected topic. This is because once you get approval to do final project (through proposal) then you will not be allowed to change your project topic.
- After the selection of an appropriate topic, students are required to seek guidance from their supervisor via SKYPE or email about whether the selected topic is feasible for final project or not. Further, if the selected topic is suitable then they will be guided about how to prepare project proposal on the selected topic.

Students are not allowed to submit copied work. Make sure that the copied work shall be marked as 'ZERO'.
